Thank you for your application for enrolment at Winchester School.

Because you do not live within the home zone specified in the school's enrolment scheme your application will be subject to the selection procedure specified in the Education Act 1989.

The Act states that:

- a. First priority must be given to any applicant who is accepted for enrolment in a special programme run by the school:
- b. Second priority must be given to any applicant who is the sibling of a current student of the school:
- c. Third priority must be given to any student who is the sibling of a former student of the school:
- d. Fourth priority must be given to any applicant who is a child of a former student of the school:
- e. Fifth priority must be given to any applicant who is either a child of an employee of the board of the school or a child of a member of the board of the school:
- f. Sixth priority must be given to all other applicants

In situations where the number of applicants exceeds the number of places available for out of zone students, selection will be by ballot. If a ballot is required at our school, the date will be advised and will be supervised by a Justice of the Peace (or, as appropriate, a practising lawyer or a sworn member of the Police or a local government returning officer). Within three school days of this date, the school will send you an email letter informing you of the outcome of the ballot. If your application has been successful, you will be asked to confirm your acceptance or rejection of the offered place within a specified time. If you do not respond within the specified time, the place will be offered to the first person on the waiting list established by the ballot.
