Thank you to all the families who participated in our recent Seesaw survey! Your feedback is invaluable as we strive to make Seesaw a valuable tool for communication and learning. We are pleased to see an overall positive response to Seesaw and appreciate your honest feedback.

This report will share back the findings and include recommendations for next steps.

What we noticed:

Many parents expressed appreciation for how Seesaw facilitates communication and provides insights into their child's learning journey. Here are some of the key benefits you highlighted:

- Staying Connected: Seesaw helps you stay informed about classroom activities and your child's progress. You value the regular updates from teachers and the ability to easily see what your child is learning and experiencing at school.
- Reinforcing Learning at Home: Seesaw provides opportunities to extend learning beyond the classroom. You find it helpful to discuss school activities with your child and build upon concepts at home.
- Teacher Communication: You appreciate the convenient way to message teachers directly through the app.
- Visual Learning: Photos and videos of classroom activities are highly valued, providing a rich understanding of your child's day.
- Engagement: We noted that some children actively use Seesaw, while others interact with it less. We will explore ways to encourage greater student participation and make Seesaw more interactive for all learners.

There was also some frustration with the app not working on certain operating systems. We have sent this feedback onto the Seesaw team.

What made us think:

- Balancing academic learning and social/physical learning.
- Reviewing the purpose of Seesaw

Now What?

We take your feedback seriously. We will be sharing this information with our staff and discussing ways to address the areas for improvement. We are particularly committed to investigating the issue of notification reliability and exploring solutions.
